



Debt Financing plan for the Medium Term Expenditure Forecast (MTEF) for 2012/2013 to 2013/2014






Tax Revenue 2013 Budget (N\$ Millions)




Non Tax Revenue 2013 Budget



Income on profits and taxes: 2013




Indirect taxes: 2013





Taxation - Proposed changes

The following tax proposals will be introduced during the course of 2012:

- Differentiated rate on the export of natural resources
- A revised Income Tax rate for non-diamond mining companies
- Environmental levy on a range of environmentally harmful products
- Introduction of a transfer duty on the sale of shares in companies owning fixed property and mineral rights or licences
