
Customs audit & investigation Are you prepared?

Customs have started to place greater emphasis on enforcement through compliance assessment reviews, audits and investigations. This is due to the greater duty-saving and cost-reduction opportunities now available for companies in particular manufacturers, importers and exporters.



Routine audits are important instruments for customs to ensure that they collect the right amount of tax. These audits help to improve the level of voluntary compliance by companies. Customs have the authority to audit all business activities relating to customs, which include imports, exports, manufacturing, licensed warehouses, drawbacks, refunds, industry assistance schemes and permits.

So, what can you expect? There are

two levels of potential interference from customs in your business operations. Routine audits of your company's customs-related activities or they may conduct investigations of suspected illegal activities by your company. From time to time, a routine audit can turn into an investigation.

Understanding of customs requirements and audit procedures will enable you to revise your operating, financial and recordkeeping functions to minimise tax exposure and ensure compliance, which can save your company from back taxes and penalties.
