Increase the monthly Old Age Grant and the Disability Grant


> N\$570m allocated for construction/renovation of educational infrastructure


- Road Fund, Income Tax, Value Added Tax and Stamp Duties Amendment Acts passed

- **N**\$2.6 billion financing facility for railway infrastructure
- Transfers to commercial public enterprises reduced from N\$2bn previously to N\$425m



#### **Revenue & Expenditure Comparison (N\$ Millions)**



## 2023/24 Annual Budget Speech: Tax Revenue Composition


#### Tax Revenue Composition 2023/24



#### **Revenue & Expenditure Comparison (N\$ Millions)**







Government Operational Expenditure Estimates by main items / sub divisions (including statutory) N\$ '000




## 2023/24 Annual Budget Speech: Departmental Expenditure



Non-mining tax rate reduction over the MTEF by 2%

Effective in FY2024/25, individual taxpayers earning less than N\$100,000 will not be subject to tax.

The tax amnesty programme will be extended for the final time. The Minister confirmed that interest and penalties will be written off if outstanding capital is fully settled by 30 October 2024.
