New proposals to amend
Customs regulations

At a glance

On 24 October, the General Department of Customs issued official letter 5162/TCHQ-GSQL setting out various proposed changes to the Vietnam Customs regime.

The draft circular is open for feedback until 8 November.



New proposals to amend Customs regulations

Key proposals instructs:

- New procedures for amending, and cancelling customs declarations; licence and specialised inspections; physical inspections per Customs Sub-department's request; and denial of goods entry.
- Amending rules for in-country export-import procedures; repair processing and recycling products; submitting customs finalisation reports, estimated bills of materials and actual bills of materials; and customs supervision of the transporting of exported goods of export production/processing companies.
- Updating regulations on declarations for additional import duties, including safeguard, anti-dumping, countervailing, and anti-circumvention measures.

Additionally, the draft rules update the provisions on customs value and classification, and introduce various forms and technical modifications.


